NABCEP PV Associate Level Prep Course

Description: Intensive 30 hour course designed to prepare individuals with basic level of electrical knowledge and general understanding of photovoltaics for the North American Board of Certified Energy Practitioners (NABCEP) PV Associate Level exam. The class will cover the Job Task Analysis (JTA) as provided by NABCEP with the NABCEP Associate Level examination. A certificate of completion for PV Associate Level Prep Course will be granted to those who successfully participate in the course and pass the two hour, 60 question exam. Due to the amount of information to be covered, classes will be limited in size. Class information will be *compact and fast paced*. This course teaches the fundamentals of photovoltaic systems and design.

Prerequisites include: Understanding of general electrical terms and concepts (voltage, amperage, difference between power and energy).
